

VISITATION GUIDELINES

Welcome to Peconic Bay Skilled Nursing & Rehabilitation. Please review the guidelines below to ensure you have a safe and enjoyable visit with your loved one.

- Visitors who have COVID-19, symptoms of COVID-19 or currently meet criteria for quarantine are not permitted to enter the facility. All visitors will be screened upon entry for these visitation exclusions.
- When you complete your screening form and are issued your sticker, please bring your screening attestation to our nursing station and sign in our visitation book. Once you sign-in, you will be directed to your resident's room.
- To ensure safe social distancing is maintained at all times, only two (2) visitors are permitted at the bedside at one time.
- Visitors under the age of 16 must be accompanied by an adult 18 years of age or older.
- Visitors are permitted to visit with residents in the following areas; the resident room, palliative atrium, multipurpose room, outdoor courtyard and palliative garden. Use of outdoor space is encourage if weather permits.
- In order to limit visitor movement throughout the facility, visitors should go directly to the resident's room or designated visitation area.
- Visitors are not permitted to utilize the staff cafeteria, rehabilitation gyms or staff offices.
- Visitors must wear a face mask or face covering which covers both the nose and mouth at all times when on the premises. Visitors are provided a face mask upon entry. Residents must also wear a face mask during visitation.
- Visitors must practice hand hygiene while in the facility.
- Visitors must maintain physical distancing of at least 6 feet between people.
- Any visitor who fails to adhere to the above will be asked to leave the premises and may be prohibited from visiting in the future.
